



SAY NO TO CONVOYS

Convoys may feel sociable when you are all going to the same destination but it is dangerous for you and other road users.

It is a driving offence when 'failing to have full view of the road and traffic ahead'. This can result in

- ❗ A maximum fine of £2,500 for Goods Vehicles/PCVs
- ❗ Maximum Discretionary disqualification
- ❗ 3 points on your licence

Remember

- ❗ Convoy driving is tailgating
- ❗ You have restricted vision
- ❗ You have less time to react to the vehicle ahead
- ❗ Tailgating increases your likelihood of being in a serious collision
